Amendments to the Florida Constitution

Amendment 1 –	Vote "Yes" to repeal the provision in the State Constitution, if you think tax dollars should not be used to fund political campaigns.
Amendment 2 –	Vote "Yes," if you believe this additional property tax exemption would provide financial help to military personnel and their families when the personnel are deployed abroad.
Amendment 4 –	Vote "No," if you think this amendment would have detrimental impacts on Florida's economy and on citizens' property rights.
Amendments 5&6 –	Vote "No," if you believe enactment of the confusing and contradictory standards mandated in Amendment 5 & 6 would increase the likelihood that any redistricting plan devised by the Florida Legislature would be subject to protracted litigation and would ultimately be replaced by a plan devised by appointed judges rather than by the people's elected representatives.
Amendment 8 –	Vote "Yes," if you think this amendment provides schools with a reasonable degree of flexibility with respect to class sizes.

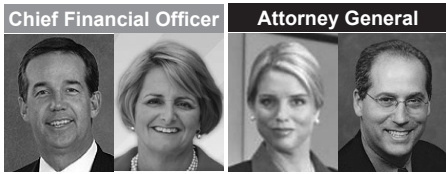

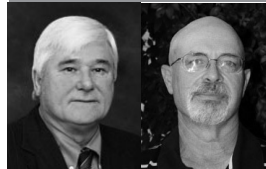
