



PROTECT YOUR VOTE

- The movement to protect your vote is made up of concerned Floridians, respected business leaders, elected officials, civic and community leaders and organizations from all political backgrounds. We are fighting to protect our vote and the right to elect individuals who represent our communities.

AMENDMENTS 5 & 6 ARE HARMFUL TO REPUBLICANS

- The political stakes couldn't be higher. We are on the verge of winning the US Senate race, Governor and Cabinet races, and possible super-majorities in one or both chambers of the Legislature. In addition, we may win up to four additional Congressional seats and are expected to gain at least one more district before we redraw districts in 2012.
- With Amendments 5 & 6 on the books, the next Marco Rubio will never come from Florida.
- This will play out in the spring of 2012 when Florida will hold their Presidential Preference Primary and Florida will host the 2012 Republican National Convention in the summer. Adding to the chaos and confusion, and opportunity for Democratic mischief.
- These amendments could very easily destroy Jeb Bush's legacy especially the A+ Plan, Florida Kid Care, tort reform, Concealed to Carry Reciprocity, and Parental Notification.
- Quite simply, "Fair Districts" is really a direct effort by the national Democrats to permanently turn Florida into a "Blue" state and do through a ballot initiative and the courts what they can't at the ballot box. Win.

AMENDMENTS 5 & 6 ARE HARMFUL TO FLORIDIANS

- Why are special interest groups outside of Florida spending millions to change our redistricting laws? By eliminating the right to have your voice heard, these groups would also open the door to allowing personal injury lawyers, big labor unions, and special interest insiders to reshape Florida's political boundaries.
